

Ming Chuan University 2023-24 Department Cup Relay Tournament

1. Mission: This competition is held to encourage students to be interested in sports, to cultivate the habit of exercise, and to promote team spirit.
2. Competition: Men's and Women's 2000m Relay Race
3. Registration Rules:
 - (1) Teams on Taipei and Taoyuan campuses participate in the preliminary races separately as time trials.
 - (2) If there are fewer than 10 men or women students in a class section, they are allowed to borrow students from other classes in their department or choose to run twice to make up the number of contestants. Insufficient numbers of women cannot be made up by male students, but insufficient numbers of men can be replaced by female students.

6. Registration Procedure: Fill out the registration form with 20 contestants (10 men and 10 women form a team), 1 male and 1 female alternate are also required when registering. Therefore, the total number to be registered for a team is 22. Each team is required to prepare two registration forms with the same content, save one copy for the team, and hand the other one in to the Physical Education Office.
7. Date of Competition: October 11 to October 17, 2023
8. Venue: Track and Field on Taipei and Taoyuan campus (If there are any adjustments due to the weather, venue or other factors, the host unit will inform all teams.)
9. Awards: The top 3 teams in the competition on Taipei campus and top 6 on Taoyuan campus will take part in the final competition. The top teams will be awarded with cash and members of these teams will be awarded with one or two Recognitions (Two Recognitions will be awarded to the first-place and second-place team members, and one Recognition to third-place through sixth-place team members.) in accordance with Clause 2, Article 7 of Student Merit and Demerit

10. Rules:

- (1) Numbers 1-10 will be female contestants and numbers 11-20 will be male contestants. All contestants will race for 100 meters.
- (2) All teams can freely arrange the sequence of the contestants within the above parameter.
- (3) All contestants must gather and stand by at the preparation point within the time limit and wait for the judge to finish the record checking procedure.
- (4) Contestants are requested to wear sports uniforms and shoes during the competition (Spiked shoes without spikes are prohibited.); running barefoot is prohibited.
- (5) All contestants must pass the baton to the next contestant within the 30m passing zone.
- (6) When a foul takes place, it will be handled according to the updated international track and field regulations recognized by the Chinese Taipei Track and Field Association.

11. Addendum:

- (1) Contestants who are shown, through actual evidence, to have violated the contest regulations will disqualify the team. Any cash rewards will be recalled.
- (2) Students who are not suited for intensive sports are asked to please not sign up for this competition.

12. Upon being approved by the president, these regulations are announced and implemented. Any revision must follow the same procedures.
