

Ming Chuan University Enforcement Rules for 3rd-year Physical Education Credit Waiver Applications

Article 1 These enforcement rules were established in accordance with Article 6, Clause 2, Section 5 of Ming Chuan University Implementation Plan for Physical Education.

Article 2 To encourage students to have regular exercise habits and be aware of their own physical fitness and promote the physical fitness project announced by Ministry of Education, physical fitness abilities are included as part of the required sports capability indications for MCU students and criteria for the required physical education course for third-year undergraduates. Qualified students may waive the course.

Article 3 Participants: All second- and third-year students.

Article 4 Assessment standard: The assessment standard is determined in accordance with “Ming Chuan University Enforcement Rules for Sports Capability Requirements.” Students passing the sports capability assessment test may waive the third-year physical education course.

Article 5 Implementation:

1. First stage recognition: Second-year undergraduate students and transfer students in the second semester of their third year shall apply for recognition after the sports capability assessment test in the second semester. Recognized second-year students may waive the third-year Physical Education Course, while recognized third-year transfer students who entered the university in the second semester may waive third-year first-semester Physical Education Course.
2. Second stage recognition: Second-year students participating in overseas exchange programs, transfer students in the first semester of the third-year and students with special circumstances shall

apply for recognition after the sports capability assessment test in the second week of the first semester. Recognized students may waive third-year Physical Education Course.

3. Third stage recognition: Third-year students who are taking physical education course may apply for recognition after the sports capability assessment re-test in the first semester. Recognized students may waive third-year Physical Education Course in the second semester.

Article 6 Exceptions:

1. Special education students evaluated and determined by Individual Support Program (ISP) of not being able to take any physical education course or special physical education course may apply as special case to waive third-year Physical Education Course.
2. Student athletes on school teams approved by Physical Education Office may waive third-year Physical Education Course.

Article 7 Upon being approved by Academic Affairs Committee Meeting and the president, these enforcement rules were announced and implemented. Any revision must follow the same procedure.
